

Lesson Title: Greek and Roman Architecture- Part two

Lesson Components	Description
Virginia Standards of Learning (VSOL)	3.1 The student will explain how the contributions of ancient Greece and Rome have influenced the present world in terms of architecture, government (direct and representative democracy), and sports.
Objective	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To help students learn about the ancient Greek and Roman architecture and how their architecture influenced modern architecture.
Assessment/Monitoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Informal- the students will have the opportunity to create their own columns.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hand out an 8x10 piece of paper.2. Have the students fold the paper in half, and then in half again to make four squares.3. Have the students draw the four different types of columns in each square.4. When they are done, have them hang up their drawings.
